Rodeo Extravaganza Coming to Lucketts!!! Professional Bull Riding, Barrel Racing and Trick Riding Make for a Fun-Filled Family Night

(LUCKETTS, VA) – Twisted K Productions is bringing its **Rodeo Extravaganza** to Lucketts' own Chapel View Farm (located just off of Lucketts Road) Saturday, June 28. The action-packed night of bull bustin', trick riding and barrel racing is brought to Lucketts by the Lucketts Community Center Advisory Board, and proceeds will help fund a variety of community programs.

Twisted K Ranch of Round Hill breeds world-class bucking bulls and recruits professional bull-riders from all over the country to participate in their events. More than 30 cowboys will compete at the Lucketts event. A rodeo clown, Roman trick rider, barrel races, live music and other entertainment will round out the night of family fun. There is a best-dressed cowboy/cowgirl contest, so everyone is encouraged to put on their boots and shine up their buckles!

"We are excited to kick off our 2008 season in Lucketts," said Karen Kester, who owns Twisted K Ranch with her husband, Glenn. "We put on a great show and are glad it can help raise funds for the community while bringing people together for a night of fun on a local farm."

The Lucketts Community Center Advisory Board first approached Twisted K about potentially bringing a rodeo component to the Lucketts Fair held in August, but organizers decided the rodeo warranted its own event. New Board members Lisa and Gary Cox volunteered their horse farm as a venue with the added benefit of an indoor arena that can accommodate the event even in the case of rain. Chapel View Farm has hosted horse shows, penning competitions and barrel racing events in the past.

"Going to the rodeo was part of growing up in Loudoun County," said Lisa Cox. "I am excited to bring this kind of event back to my community so my kids and their friends can have some of those same experiences."

The Lucketts Community Center Advisory Board (LCCAB) is a volunteer organization that supports the Old Lucketts School building and related community center programs. This past year, LCCAB paid to build a new bathroom in the community center's child care room and provided approximately \$25,000 for scholarships, community center programs, English for Families classes and donations to community organizations and shelters.

Tickets are \$15 at the gate; advance tickets are available for \$12 (call 703-443-6730 or (703) 927-7704); Kids under 6 are free. Gates open at 5:00 pm and the show begins at 7:00 pm. Bleacher seating is available and bring lawn chairs are welcome. Pets, coolers, outside food and alcohol are not permitted. There will be a food vendor on site. Parking is free.
